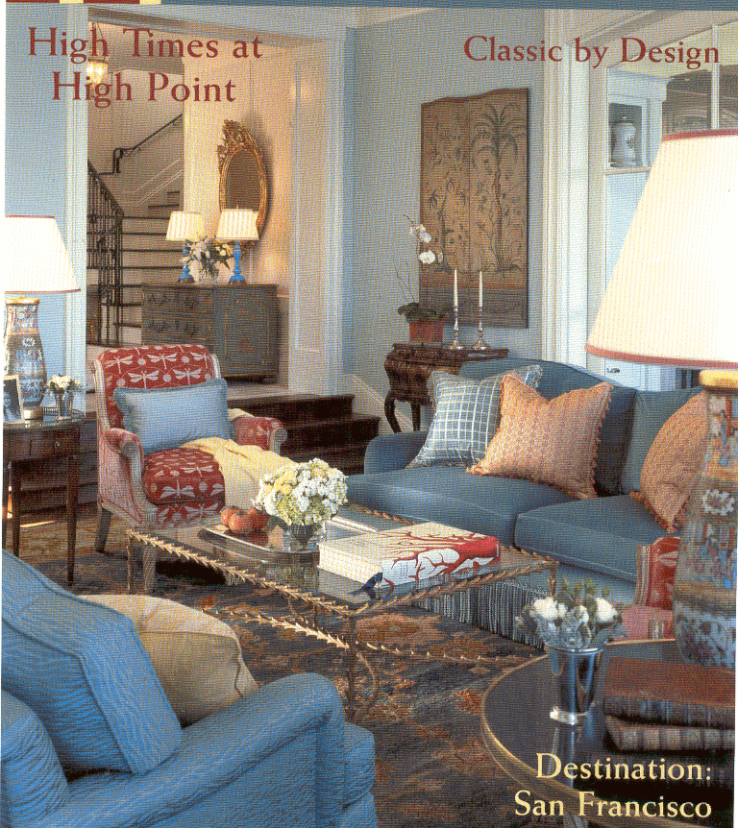

Gerard Onley, founder of **Onley Make Believe**, has been making pillows, placements, and table runners for the San Francisco design community since 1996. Not wanting to categorize the pieces as either traditional or modern, Onley says, "I try to keep the lines simple and clean, that way they blend into any type of environment." This seems in keeping with the way the city approaches design. "San Francisco has its own beat, and I find that a lot of people here do their own mix, they don't follow a blueprint," he says. Originally from Louisiana, Onley finds the contrast in locale inspiring. "It's a great thing, coming from a small town like I did. San Francisco gives you a small-town atmosphere but it gives you everything that any major city could possibly offer."

Even though she's already featured in this issue of *FFI* (page 18), we have to point out that Kendall Wilkinson Robinson's **Threshold** is one of the best design stops you can make on your trip. Walking by the front windows of this fine retail and design center offers an exquisite juxtaposition of the old and the new. The store houses everything from Venetian glass mirrors and gilded candlesticks to contemporary dimensional and organic sculptures by Adam P. Gale. Some of the lines carried at Threshold include the Missoni Home Collection and *Maison de Vacances* pillows and throws. The Raynald Limoge tabletop is a must-see as is the Ercuis Silverware, Flatware, and Gift collection. Robinson also custom designs textiles and furniture, offering a one-of-a-kind experience to her clients. ■
